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On March 21, 2019, the Division of Consumer Protection (the "Division") filed a Renewed Motion to Convert Informal Hearing in the referenced matter (the "Motion"). In the Opposition filed jointly by the Respondents, the Respondents have requested oral argument on the Motion.


Owing to the ten calendar day timing limitation of U.A.C. R151-4-304, the presiding officer invited input from counsel for the parties regarding irreconcilable conflicts with a preferred oral argument date of April 16<sup>th</sup> and an alternate date of April 17<sup>th</sup>. All parties have provided input by the deadline indicated in the initial Notice of Oral Argument and the April 17<sup>th</sup> date is available for all, although the Respondents have suggested that the oral argument could be held on the same date as the prehearing conference on April 23<sup>rd</sup>.

- The April 23<sup>rd</sup> date of the prehearing conference does not comport with the ten day hearing requirement of U.A.C. R151-4-304, and
- The content of the Scheduling Order that will issue after the prehearing conference will be materially different, depending on whether the case proceeds as an informal or formal proceeding. The presiding officer intends to rule on the Motion prior to the April 23, 2019 date of the prehearing conference. Such ruling will permit the parties to more appropriately address the scheduling discussion at the prehearing conference.

Based on the foregoing and for good cause appearing,

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that oral argument on the Motion will be heard on Wednesday, April 17, 2019 at 10:00 a.m. in Room 403 of the Heber M. Wells Building, Salt Lake City, Utah.
