**AGREED ORDER REGARDING
DISCOVERY DISPUTES**

WHEREAS, during the course of this Action discovery disputes may arise that require intervention by the Administrative Law Judge; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the parties and the tribunal to resolve discovery disputes as efficiently as possible;


IT IS HERBY STIUPLATED, AGREED, AND ORDERED THAT:

The parties will make a good faith effort to resolve any discovery disputes that arise during the course of this Action without the intervention of the Administrative Law Judge.

However, if the parties are unable to reach agreement, the moving party may submit to the Administrative Law Judge via email a letter of no more than five (5) pages describing the dispute and the relief requested. The opposing party may submit via email to the Administrative Law Judge a letter response of no more than five (5) pages within four (4) business days of the submission of the moving party's letter.

If any party would like to be heard regarding the dispute they must so state in their letter submission. If such request is made, the Administrative Law Judge may, in his discretion, hold a conference to hear argument regarding the dispute. Otherwise, the Administrative Law Judge will issue a decision on the basis of the letter submissions of the parties.
